HELLO DROP-IN FAMILIES,

We understand that getting you back into your daily routine is very important and we want to help you get there. Re-opening Adventure Alley and Toy Room gives you the opportunity to complete your daily workout and provides a social and engaging environment for your child. Safety has been and continues to be our top priority. To ensure the safety and well-being of your child the following requirements and safety precautions have been put in place:

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS & REQUIREMENTS:

Parents, please take your child's temperature before arriving at the Y. If your child is feeling ill or has **ANY** of the following symptoms, please stay home. Your child must be symptom free for at least **24 hours** or more before returning to YMCA programs.

Temperature of 100 degrees or higher	Chills
Vomiting or nausea	Diarrhea
Shortness of breath	Fatigue
Muscle or body aches	Headache
New loss of taste or smell	Sore throat
Congestion or runny nose	Cough
Symptoms of communicable disease	Inability to participate in regular daily activities

- Anyone 5 years and older are required to wear a mask at the YMCA. Exemptions include but not limited to; individuals who have difficulty breathing, medical conditions that prevent wearing a face covering, sensory sensitivities, developmental disabilities or when eating or drinking.
- Do not bring in any outside food or drinks other than a **labeled** water bottle.
- Parents must provide a bag with diapers and wipes for your child.
- Staff will assist your child with washing hands upon entry.
- When exiting Drop-In, please have your child wash or sanitize their hands.
- We sanitize surfaces and frequently touched areas before and during operation, all toys are cleaned and disinfected at the end of each day.
- Additional cleaning procedures have been put in place after closing.
- First Come, First Serve. The numbers of children allowed in Drop-In will be limited, and if at capacity, families will be turned away. Y Employees using Drop-In during their work shifts will need to make a reservation.
- **No** Family Play Time or Wee Deliver service will be offered at this time.
- Drop-In is only available to parents while working out or participating in a class-no congregating or gathering in the lobby.
- Only one parent at a time at check-in and parents are not allowed beyond check-in area of the Drop-In entrance.
- Ages: Toy Room: 6 weeks-2.5 years old, Adventure Alley 2.5-8 years old. *We are temporarily accepting children up to 8 years old.
- Drop-In may close 30 minutes before scheduled ending time if there are no children present.
- Late pick up Fee: A minimum late fee of \$5 will be charged for any late pick up, plus \$5 for every additional 15 minutes.
- Drop-In child care is only available with single-parent family and family memberships. No away members at this time.
- Play Tunnels will be CLOSED until further notice.
- If you are a nursing mom, you will need to access the nursing area in the adult locker room located off the wellness center downstairs.
- All children are required to wear socks. Socks are available at the Service Desk for \$1.
- 2-hour limit per day- you must remain in the facility at all times.
