Camp Maintenance/Custodial Staff Approximately May 25-September 24, 2026

Seasonal rate starting at \$13.25/hr (depending on experience and qualifications)

Under the direction of the Camp Director, this position will perform a wide variety of routine maintenance tasks designated to help maintain the YMCA camp grounds, property, equipment, and cleanliness.

SKILLS & QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ability to lift a minimum of 10 pounds and a maximum of 50 pounds, floor to waist height, ongoing throughout the shift.
- Ability to carry a minimum of 10 pounds and a maximum of 50 pounds, frequently throughout the shift.
- Ability to push or pull a minimum of 10 pounds and a maximum of 120 pounds (with the use of a dolly) frequently throughout the shift.
- Ability to stand and/or walk for 1 10 hours per day.
- Ability to climb a step stool or ladder, reach forward and overhead, bend, and stoop frequently throughout the shift. Squatting included.
- Ability to learn and operate camp maintenance vehicles including lawn mower and brush hog.
- Must be able to be positive role model working around and interacting with kids and pass all licensing requirements including fingerprint background check.

HOURS:

Camp Glacier Hollow has a full schedule of programs during the summer months, including programs that continue on some weekends and holidays. Typical schedule for this position is 20–25 hours, Mon—Fri, with exact hours determined by needs of maintenance work.
